



AGP HIRE AGREEMENT

As the main hirer you agree to the term & conditions set out below and will be the person responsible to ensure the group complies with the agreement as follows:

- The site will not be supervised during your visit. You will be responsible for the Health & Safety of your group.
- Adequate First Aid provision must be made by the Hirer for the duration of the booking. In the event of an accident requiring further medical attention call 999. All accidents must be reported to the club by emailing andythompson@brackleytownfc.co.uk
- Also in case of emergencies you can contact Andy Thompson on 07977 253151 or 07483 140534
- Booked times must be strictly adhered to.
- All play must end promptly.
- Children's groups - Should be supervised at all times by an adult of 18 years or older suitable for the requirements of the activity taking place arranged by the Hirer. This includes their arrival and departure and may therefore be outside the booked times. Unless specially requested and booked, the hire does not include any equipment other than goal posts. It is the responsibility of the Hirer to ensure the adult to child ratios are met at all times

*OFSTED ADULT-TO-CHILD RATIOS FOR ENGLAND AND WALES

- For 0 to 2 years – one adult to every 3 children (1:3)
- For 2 to 3 years – one adult to every 5 children (1:5)
- For 3 to 8 years – one adult to every 8 children (1:8)
- For over-8s – one adult to every 10 children (1:10)

There should always be more than one adult for any group and at least one should be female. Helpers under 18 years old count as children and not adults in these ratios. If you have a number of teenage helpers, you will need more adults not fewer.

- The goal nets must not be dragged along the pitch. This will damage the pitch. If the pitch is damaged, repair works will be invoiced to the Hirer.
- Access - The gate at the top of the terraces is to be used as an entrance. The pitch/facility is not to be entered any other way.
- Walk on the tarmac path. Do not walk on any other grass/mud areas.
- Players - must not play at the side of the pitch or on surrounding grass area.
- Bins are provided outside of the pitch. These are to be used.
- No food or alcoholic drink, chewing gum or smoking is allowed on the pitch or its surrounds AT ANY TIME.
- No dogs are permitted in the stadium/grounds.

- Smoking is only permitted in the designated areas of the main grounds not within the AGP facility.
- The club is surrounded by a residential area, unacceptable behaviour will not be tolerated.
- To help protect the surface - The management draws your attention to the following:
- Only permitted footwear allowed in the grounds:
 - Moulded studded trainer/football shoe
 - Multi-studded trainer
 - Astro turf boots
- Unauthorised footwear
 - Spikes
 - Blades
 - Flat-soled trainers
 - Studded football shoe
 - **Strictly no metal studs**

- Payment - all payments for bookings must be paid for in advance.
- Brackley Town FC reserves the right to close or prohibit the use of any of its facilities If at any time in its own opinion the facilities are or will be unfit for use. In such cases, no charges will be due, and the Hirer will receive a refund of any fees pre-paid. Brackley Town FC will not be held responsible for any financial or other loss arising as a result of such withdrawal of facilities.

- In the case of cancellation of a booking by the Hirer, where at least 7 days' notice has not been given, the Hirer shall be liable for the hiring fee, unless the facility is re-let to the satisfaction of Brackley Town FC.
- Insurance – Brackley Town FC is under no liability whatsoever in respect of personal injury, loss or damage which may be incurred by those using the Artificial Sports Pitch or Community Arena, unless it is proved that Brackley Town FC has been negligent. Furthermore, Brackley Town FC, accepts no responsibility for any claims, actions, demands, proceedings or costs arising out of any claims made against the Hirer by a third party, and the Hirer shall indemnify Brackley Town FC against all such claims which may be brought against Brackley Town FC arising out of or incidental to the hire of the facilities and equipment.
- Damage - the Hirer agrees to pay Brackley Town FC, on demand the cost of repairing or making good any damage to the pitch, to the buildings or to the furniture, equipment and effects therein which may be damaged or destroyed by or in consequence of the booking.
- Admissions – Brackley Town FC, reserves the right at its absolute discretion to refuse the admission of or to evict any person from the pitch or its grounds.
- Supervision - the Hirer is to be responsible for:
 1. Ensuring that the activity carried out is supervised by a responsible person as detailed above.
 2. The administration, organisation and running of the event.
 3. Leaving all premises, including facilities, changing rooms and toilets as clean and tidy as possible - an extra charge may be levied on groups who do not comply.
 4. BrackleyTown FC, reserves the right to refuse to renew an application where: the group has previously under-used or abused the facilities.
- Vat payable where applicable.

I have read and understood the above. Should my club/booking not adhere to the criteria outlined, we will accept full responsibility in the case of negligence and forfeit our rights to use the facility.

I have read and understood the current government guidelines in respect of COVID19 Pandemic and am responsible for all persons belonging to my booking scanning the QR Code on entering the facility. Masks will be worn when walking to and from the facility and hand sanitisation will be used wherever appropriate.
